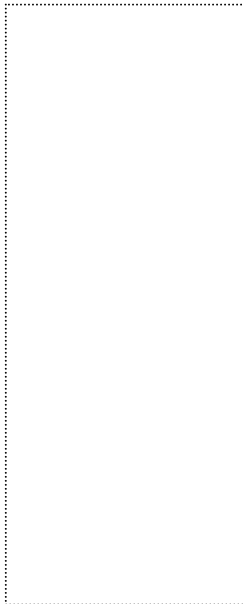

Excellent, Open, Novice FAST Classes, Excellent, Open, Novice Standard Classes, Excellent, Open, Novice Jumpers With Weaves Classes – Ring 1– Laura A English

Levels will run in the order shown above. In both Excellent and Novice, B teams will run first then A teams. Preferred teams will run with appropriate level and will follow dogs jumping the same height. We are running a ONE ring trial, class conflicts will NOT exist at this trial. If you are doing conformation, please advise the trial secretary at what time your class is scheduled for judging, if we have numerous dogs ending up with breed conflicts we will do whatever we have to do, however classes MUST be run together.

Entry is not valid unless on current version **AEAGL2-01/01/07 (03-06) of the entry form approved by AKC. Entry is not valid without the agreement page attached to the entry form! Please take the time to read the agreement before sending in entry. Previous versions of this agreement will be accepted with your entry, but the new version MUST be signed when you check in at the trial.**

Move Up Information

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is **made in writing to the Trial Secretary no later than Monday, May 25th at 6.00PM** (via e-mail to boredgypsy@aol.com acceptable). Dogs moved up will be entered at the end of the running order. **Please note: A change in entry from Reg. to Preferred and vice versa is considered a change of entry NOT a move up and cannot be completed after closing date.**

Obstacle familiarization will NOT be offered at these trials.

A warm up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Either mail a copy of the AKC Jump Height Card with your entry (preferred method), present it at check-in, or the dog must be measured, except for 24" class dogs, unless a VMO or REP is present. All heights are as measured at the withers.

Regular Class jump height divisions:

- 8 inches for dogs 11 inches and under
- 12 inches for dogs 14 inches and under
- 16 inches for dogs 18 inches and under
- 20 inches for dogs 22 inches and under
- 24 inches for dogs over 22 inches
- 26 inches at owner's discretion

Dogs entered in Preferred Classes jump at a height 4" lower than the minimum height they would be required to jump in Regular classes as listed above:

- 4 inches for dogs 11 inches and under
- 8 inches for dogs 14 inches and under
- 12 inches for dogs 18 inches and under
- 16 inches for dogs 22 inches and under
- 20 inches for dogs over 22 inches

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each Standard, JWW jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. MACH Rosettes and bars will be awarded to dogs earning their title at our trial. The Club reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value. All prizes must be claimed the day of the trial – none will be mailed.
Silver Plated frames will be awarded to the first place winners of all groups.
All participants will be awarded a Dog Bowl w/Treats

IMPORTANT

To speed the check in process, ACCC will accept a photocopy of a dog's jump height card to be submitted with the entries for this trial. All entries received without a jump height card will be required to check in with the trial secretary the morning of the trial. You will not be allowed to run without your height card, or being measured. Please remember to submit a copy of your jump height card with your entry **OR** email a scanned copy to GilmrFrank@aol.com.

Judge will be available 15 minutes before each class for measuring dogs that did not present a height card and for those without height cards. This is the time you **MUST** be measured. Dogs not measured that need to be will not be eligible to qualify.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to Chinese Cresteds only, over the age of 15 months, that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP or PAL numbers as Chinese Cresteds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

If an email address is included an e-mail confirmation will be sent.

- 1 No food will be available on site.
- 2 Confirmation and schedules will be emailed after entry closing, or mailed if no email address.
- 3 Numbers can be picked up at the trial upon check in if you've sent a valid height card.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all obstacles safely. Lameness and deaf dogs will be excused.

*** IMPORTANT NOTICES ***

1. This trial will be held under AKC rules and regulations for agility trials. Exhibitors are expected to be familiar with these rules and regulations.
2. Participants who leave dogs, equipment or personal belongings unattended do so at their own risk. The show giving club and the owner(s) of the site will not be responsible for dogs, equipment or personal belongings, nor for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog, whether the result of accident or any other cause.
3. All dogs must be kept on leash or in crates at all times except when competing. The only exception is in the designated warm-up jump area. Dogs (even on leash) are not permitted in the concessions area.
4. There will be ample parking and areas for crating dogs. Food concessions will be available during the trials.
5. Participants will be responsible for clean conditions (including picking up after the dogs in their care) around crates, tents and parking spaces.
6. All Chinese Cresteds fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with AKC OR Dogs that have AKC Limited Registration or have been granted an ILP or PAL are eligible to participate.
7. Participants shall be governed by any rules and regulations of civil authorities and/or location restrictions. Please obey all posted signs.
8. Parents or guardians must be responsible for children. Children must be under adult supervision at all times.
9. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A collection fee (\$50.00) will be added to the amount of each returned check.
10. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the judge or veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Withdrawal must be made in writing to the Trial Secretary before the closing date (email is acceptable). Withdrawn entries will have their checks shredded.
11. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
12. Entry fees will be refunded for bitches in season or injured dogs after the closing date if a veterinarian certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary. There will be a \$15 per day/ per dog fee retained by ACCC to cover AKC Recording & Judges fees. No refunds for duplicate entries.

*** IMPORTANT NOTICES (CONTINUED) ***

13. Obstacles will conform to the requirements stated in the 2007 edition of AKC Agility Rules & Regulations.
14. Dogs under 6 months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials.
15. No prong collars allowed.
16. Aggressive dogs will be asked to leave the show site without refund of any fees.
17. Please enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope or post card with your entry or include your e-mail address on entry form if you would like confirmation of entry receipt.
18. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, there will be no refund of any fees paid.
19. You can be eliminated if you do not show your label during your run, please wear them.
20. **Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.** Any dogs showing signs of illness or pain will be removed from competition and no refund will be granted.
21. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the gate when it is their turn to run. Judges are not required to wait for any dog holding up a class.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
