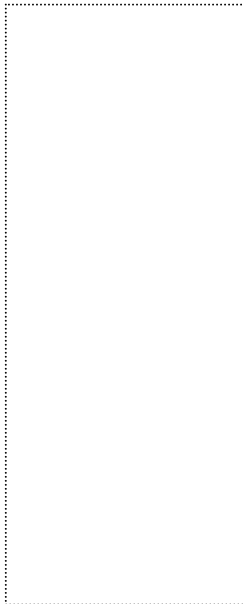

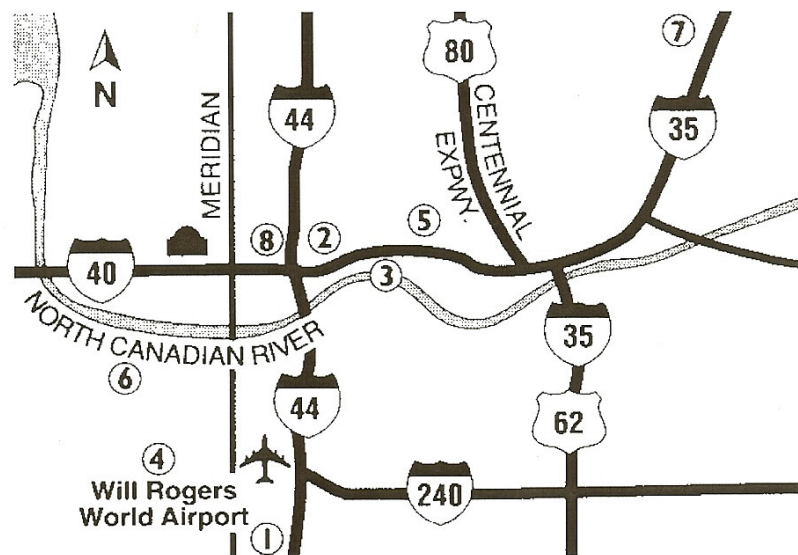

Levels will run in the order shown above. In both Excellent and Novice, B teams will run first then A teams. Preferred teams will run with appropriate level and will follow dogs jumping the same height.

Entry is not valid unless on current version or entry form approved by AKC (AEAGL2 (09/10) OLA Edit V7.0P). Entry is not valid without the agreement page attached to the entry form! Please take the time to read the agreement before sending in entry. Previous versions of this agreement will be accepted with your entry, but the new version MUST be signed when you check in at the trial.

Move Up Information

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is **made in writing to the Trial Secretary no later than Monday, May 16th at 6.00PM** (via e-mail to lettymc@comcast.net) for the Friday Specialty Trial and Saturday Trial Toy Breed. **No emails will be accepted between Monday, May 16th, 2011 after the move up closing and Thursday, May 19th 2011.** Dogs moved up will be entered at the end of the running order.

Please note: A change in entry from Reg. To Preferred and vice versa is considered a change of entry NOT a move up and cannot be completed after closing date.

Obstacle familiarization will NOT be offered at these trials.

A warm up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

CATALOGS: Catalogs will be available on a **Pre-ordered/Pre-Paid** basis. Catalogs will be laid out in class format with the following information: owner information, full name of dog, date of birth, sire, dam and Handler. Indicate if you want a catalog on the entry form and include \$10.00 per catalog along with your entries. Trial supply of catalogs will be **VERY limited** and will be on a first come, first served basis at a cost of \$15.00 at the trial. One catalog will cover all three trial days.

*** IMPORTANT NOTICES ***

1. This trial will be held under AKC rules and regulations for agility trials. Exhibitors are expected to be familiar with these rules and regulations.
2. Participants who leave dogs, equipment or personal belongings unattended do so at their own risk. The show giving club and the owner(s) of the site will not be responsible for dogs, equipment or personal belongings, nor for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog, whether the result of accident or any other cause.
3. All dogs must be kept on leash or in crates at all times except when competing. The only exception is in the designated warm-up jump area. Dogs (even on leash) are not permitted in the concessions area.
4. There will be ample parking and areas for crating dogs. Food concessions will be available during the trials.
5. Participants will be responsible for clean conditions (including picking up after the dogs in their care) around crates, tents and parking spaces.
6. All dogs fifteen(15) months of age or older that are registered with AKC OR Dogs that have AKC Limited Registration or dogs of an AKC-registerable breed that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) are eligible to participate.
7. Participants shall be governed by any rules and regulations of civil authorities and/or location restrictions. Please obey all posted signs.
8. Parents or guardians must be responsible for children. Children must be under adult supervision at all times.
9. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A collection fee (\$50.00) will be added to the amount of each returned check.
10. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the judge or veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Refunds due to withdrawal must be made in writing to the Trial Secretary stating if the competitor wishes for the check to be shredded or to be returned (email is acceptable).
11. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
12. Obstacles will conform to the current requirements of the AKC Agility Rules & Regulations.

*** IMPORTANT NOTICES (CONTINUED) ***

13. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
14. Obstacles will conform to the current requirements of the AKC Agility Rules & Regulations..
15. Dogs under 6 months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials. No prong collars allowed.
16. Aggressive dogs will be asked to leave the show site without refund of any fees.
17. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from the competition by action of the Trial Committee.
18. Entry fees will be refunded for bitches in season or injured dogs after the closing date if a veterinarian certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary. There will be a \$15 per day/ per dog fee retained by ACCC to cover AKC Recording & Judges fees. No refunds for duplicate entries.
19. Please enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope or post card with your entry or include your e-mail address on entry form if you would like confirmation of entry receipt.
20. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, there will be no refund of any fees paid.
21. You can be eliminated if you do not show your label during your run, please wear them.
22. **Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.** Any dogs showing signs of illness or pain will be removed from competition and no refund will be granted.
23. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the gate when it is their turn to run. Judges are not required to wait for any dog holding up a class.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each Standard, JWW & FAST jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. MACH Rosettes and bars will be awarded to dogs earning their title at our trial. The Club reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value. All prizes must be claimed the day of the trial – none will be mailed

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Either mail a copy of the AKC Jump Height Card with your entry (preferred method), present it at check-in, or the dog must be measured, except for 24" class dogs, unless a VMO or REP is present. All heights are as measured at the withers.

Regular Class jump height divisions:

- 8 inches for dogs 11 inches and under
- 12 inches for dogs 14 inches and under
- 16 inches for dogs 18 inches and under
- 20 inches for dogs 22 inches and under
- 24 inches for dogs over 22 inches
- 26 inches at owner's discretion

Dogs entered in Preferred Classes jump at a height 4" lower than the minimum height they would be required to jump in Regular classes as listed above:

- 4 inches for dogs 11 inches and under
- 8 inches for dogs 14 inches and under
- 12 inches for dogs 18 inches and under
- 16 inches for dogs 22 inches and under
- 20 inches for dogs over 22 inches

IMPORTANT

Judge will be available ½ hour before each class Friday, Saturday and Sunday for measuring dogs that did not present a height card and for those without height cards. This is the time you **MUST** be measured. Dogs not measured that need to be will not be eligible to qualify.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds (Chinese Cresteds Only on Friday and Toy Breeds Only Saturday and Sunday) that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

If an email address is included an e-mail confirmation will be sent.

- 1 Food will be available on site.
- 2 Confirmation and schedules will be emailed after entry closing, or mailed if no email address.
- 3 Numbers can be picked up at the trial upon check in if you sent a valid height card. Envelopes will be sorted in order by Last Name of Handler.
- 4 Please see the included map for the location of the show.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all obstacles safely. Lamé and deaf dogs will be excused.
